### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- ▶ Entry fee is \$50.00; \$45.00 for CSA members. Artists may enter up to three (3) pieces in a category. Multiple entries are accepted as separate disciplines and a fee of \$50/\$45 is assessed for each category. Accepted entrants must be residents of New Mexico.
- ▶ Accepted art forms include: painting, sculpture, drawing, mixed-media, jewelry, photography, printmaking, and ceramics.
- ▶ Entries must be submitted in clear JPEG, PNG or HEIC image files to Juried Art Services, [www.juriedartservices.com](http://www.juriedartservices.com). Access the **Old Church Fine Arts Show** icon on their site; follow all directions for your entry. Artist support from **JAS: 954-418-2827** or [support@jurying.net](mailto:support@jurying.net).
- ▶ All art must be original in concept by the artist and must not have been previously exhibited in an Old Church Fine Arts Show. Accepted entries must be gallery ready, and all work must be for sale. Giclée accepted. Reference Juried Art Services Perspectives for requirements. Size limitation is 24-inches by 36-inches or a total of no more than 900 square inches, before framing.
- ▶ This is a selling show. Historically, works under \$1000 sell best.
- ▶ Art drop-off is Monday afternoon September 30. Artists' Reception will be Friday evening October 4.
- ▶ Accepted entrants are requested to work one 3½-hour shift during the show. Show hours: 10 a.m. to 5 p.m.
- ▶ A 25% donation is collected on all items sold at the show. It will be used toward preservation and maintenance of Historic Old San Ysidro Church.
